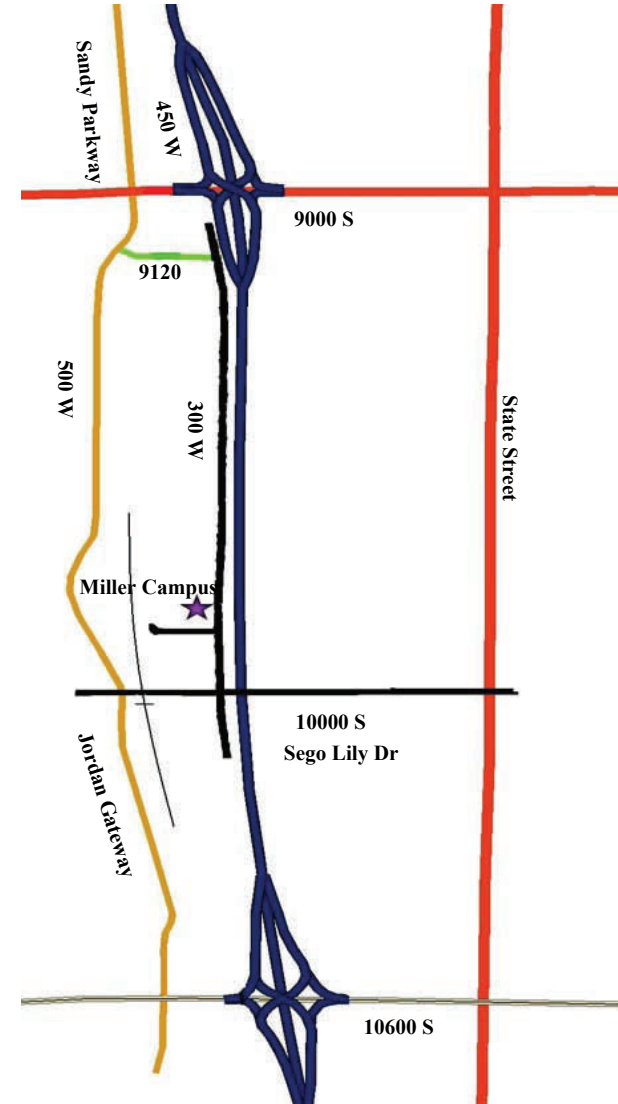

Driving from The North:

Take I-15 South to Exit 295 (9000 South). Exit right (west) onto 9000 South and proceed to 450 west (1st light). Turn left (south), go to 9120 South & turn left (east), go to 300 West (frontage road) & turn right (south). Proceed 6 blocks south along frontage road.



Driving from the South:

Take I-15 North to Exit 293 (10600 South) after exiting, turn left (west) and proceed to Jordan Gateway. Turn right (north), go to light at 10000 South (Sego Lily Dr) in Sandy. Turn right (East), go over the railroad tracks & turn left (north) on 300 West (frontage road). Proceed two blocks north along frontage road.
